TCA ARSHAG DICKKRANIAN SCHOOL STUDENTS ELECT STUDENT COUNCIL OFFICERS

Los Angeles, September 27, 2010 - Friday, September 17th was Student Council Election Day at TCA Arshag Dickranian Armenian School. Students ranging from 5th through 12th grades got in line in the morning to cast their ballots for the candidates of their choice. Then, at 1:30 p.m., they gathered at the Walter and Laurel Karabian Hall to get the election results as the winners' names were announced by Principal Vartkes Kourouyan.

Thus, after weeks of preparation and rigorous campaigning by displaying placards, making speeches, participating in debates and answering questions asked by a panel of teachers, the following slate of six candidates were elected to serve on the Executive Committee during the 2010-2011 scholastic year: Morris Sarafian as President, Harout Seropian as Vice President; Nvard Agazaryan as Secretary, Maria Gukasyan as Treasurer, Hovanes Supikyan as Assistant Secretary and Lucy Agekyan as Assistant Treasurer.

The Student Council of Arshag Dickranian School serves as the link between students and the school administration and is elected annually by the students. The officers are selected from the 11th grade and have two representatives from 5th through 12th grades serving as advisors. The Student Council's responsibilities include coordinating student activities, tutoring weak students, organizing events such as Thanksgiving, Halloween and Christmas parties and conducting several fundraisers throughout the year.

Throughout the years the previous councils have been successful in transferring over a hundred thousand dollars to the school Board of Trustees through their annual activities as a consequence of which the Board has dedicated the junior laboratory at the school's new wing to the Student Councils by placing a special plaque at the entrance of the laboratory.
